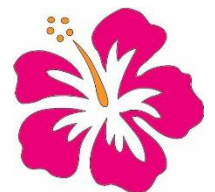

Carolyn Bolen, Sandy Terry, Sandy Denault, and Pat Pederson ready to tee it up.

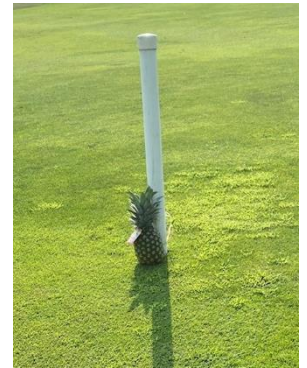

Good kitchen help is hard to find.



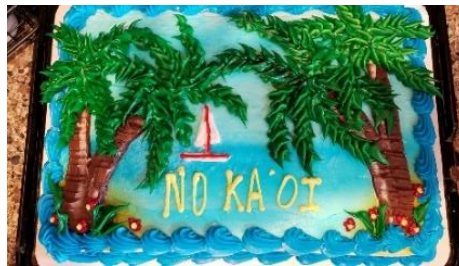
