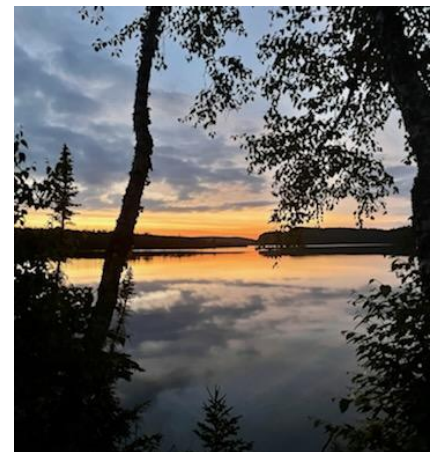
Since the theme was Hawaiian Hula, Ruthie and Wendy cleverly repurposed the shirts they bought for our Calcutta last summer. They look like bookends!

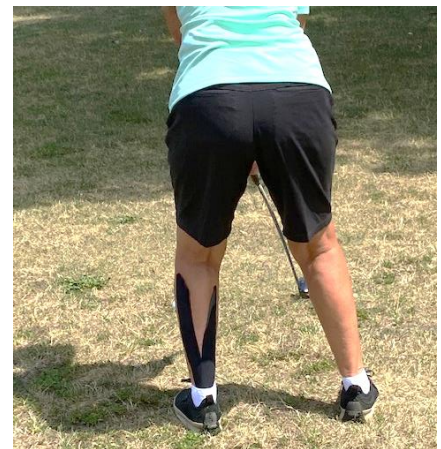
## 2022 Singles Match Madness
