**What's the title of the current chapter of your life?** Loving retirement!



Waiting out a rain delay is a perfect time for **Ruthie Pallow** to model this hat. Members are sporting stylish hats this year. Look for a feature on them soon.




X marks the spot. Not sure what this is all about but makes for a pretty interesting photo.
