1st place with a score of 118: **Jane Cacich, Konny Fitch, Theresa Peterson, and Bertsie Rannenberg.** \$25 each.


2nd place with a score of 121: **Annie Nixon, Ruth Pallow, Tillie Wolske.** \$20 each.
